### Registered Nurse to Bachelor of Science in Nursing (RN-to-BSN) Program Curriculum Progression

The five semester Nursing sequence is offered every fall, spring, and summer depending on student demand. The sequence includes summer term.

Additional courses (if needed) to meet graduation requirements, including General Education and Liberal Studies, may be completed before, during or after the five semesters of Nursing. Students will work with their advisor after admission and transfer credit evaluation to determine whether previous or transfer courses meet specific requirements and create a graduation plan.
